¹ Constitution, Laws, and Regulations of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Minnesota: Section 6.

Each member (except honorary members) shall be entitled, when present at any Grand Conclave, to one vote in all the proceedings, except that the presiding officer shall vote only in case of a tie, when he shall decide the issue. Such members, except Past Grand Commanders and Past Commanders, may, if absent, vote by proxy, said proxy being any duly elected and installed officer of the same Commandery and being present and producing a certificate of appointment signed by his principal. Unless otherwise provided herein or by Grand Encampment law, all questions shall be decided by a majority vote of all votes cast.
